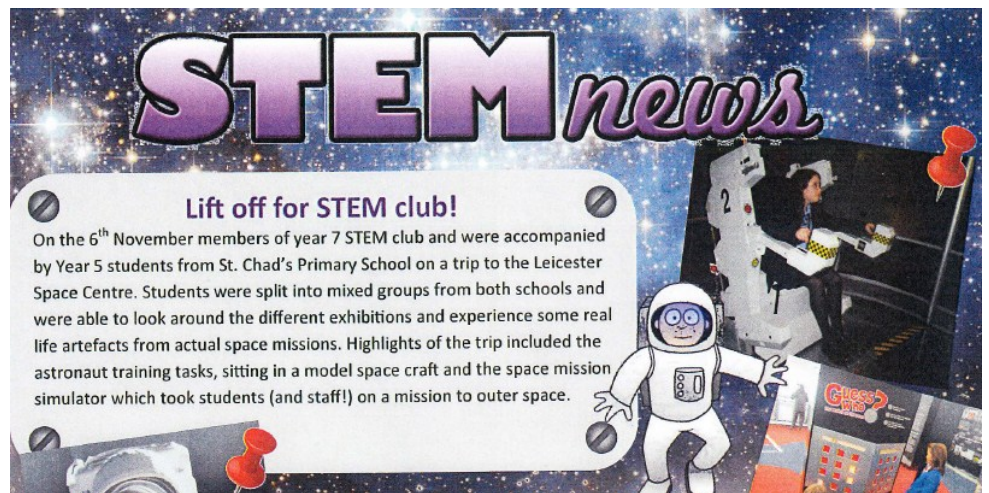




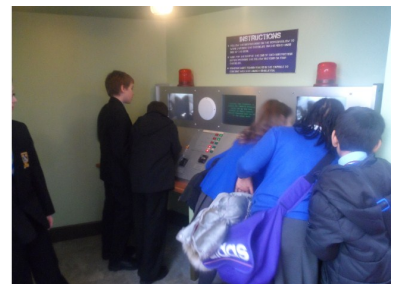
Shared Practice with Bishop Challoner Catholic College
